Exempted players in the 2010 World Deaf Golf Championships (WDGC).

The World Deaf Golf Federation (WDGF) will, in accordance with the Tournament Rules for the World Deaf Golf Championships, give exemption to the following players to participate in the 2010 WDGC;

a) The previous individual champions in each class:

Ladies Tournament: Linda Davis, Australia
Men's Senior Tournament: Rob Cundy, Canada

b) The present board members of the WDGF:

The exempted players can participate in the WDGC regardless if their country is sending the maximum number of allowed participants.

Exempted players shall pay the entrance fee, and the final date for entering the Championships shall be the same as for the other players.

Exempted players are only allowed to play in the individual tournaments. If they want to play in their national team they shall enter the Championships the normal way and not as exempted players.

The exempted player's handicap must not differ too much from the handicap limit for entering the Men's-, Ladies- and Men's Senior Tournament.
